The checklist is for home-buyers, -sellers and realtors to use as a companion for most Multiple Listing Services (MLS) listings. It is intended as a guide to provide examples of general expectations for accessible features listed in the MLS.

- □ Low pile carpeting or no-carpeting
- Lowered switches/ outlets/ controls mounted between 18" and 48" above floor
- No flooring height changes between room

ACCESSIBLE BEDROOM (select all that apply)

- Minimum of 36" wide level pathway to bedroom
- Closet bars adjustable or at least one bar at 48" above floor level
- Window controls are within 40" of the floor

ACCESSIBLE BATHROOM (select all that

apply)

- Minimum of 36" wide level pathway to bathroom opening
- Lowered switches/ outlets/ controls mounted between 18" and 48" above floor
- □ Accessible full bath
- Accessible half bath
- Sink with space for knee & foot under counter
- □ Minimum of 32" wide clear door opening
- Grab bars

ACCESSIBLE KITCHEN (select all that apply)

- Minimum of 36" wide level pathway to kitchen area
- □ Shelves under 48" or pull-down shelves
- Well-lit work surfaces
- Slide open oven
- □ Accessible outlets (not behind counter)
- Accessible switches (not behind counter)
- Raised dishwasher
- 60" turning radius

- Lowered switches/ outlets/ controls mounted between 18" and 48" above floor
- □ Minimum of 32" wide clear door opening
- □ Low pile carpeting or no-carpeting
- Pocket door
- □ Wide/ double door
- □ Bottom of the mirror is at 40" maximum
- □ Counters between 32" to 34" high
- Grab bars by/ in shower
- Scald control faucet
- □ 60" turning radius
- Lever faucets
- Roll-in shower
- Pocket door
- Grab bars by toilet
- □ Lifted/ raised toilet
- Contrasting color between work surfaces and backsplash
- Range or cooktop with controls on the front or side of burners
- Variable counter heights
- □ Counter is between 32" 34" from floor
- Sink with space for knee & foot under counter
- Raised toe kicks
- Button/ knobs on stove and microwave (no flat panel controls)

ACCESSIBLE UTILITY (select all that apply)

- Minimum of 36" wide level pathway to utility room
- Sink with space for knee & foot under counter
- Shelves and cabinets between 18" 48" above floor level
- □ Front-load washer and dryer
- □ Minimum of 32" wide clear door opening
- Pedestal or raised appliances
- Circuit breaker panel with top control of the breaker panel at 48" maximum above floor level

MODIFICATIONS FOR HEARING/ VISION (select all that apply)

- Visual doorbell
- Contrasting color between work surfaces and backsplash
- Adjustable lighting
- All appliances have visual and audible cues
- Smart house features for verbal commands

- □ Visual smoke/ fire alarms
- Open floor plan
- Button knobs on appliances (no flat panel controls)
- Talking thermostat

Elevator installed

□ Stairlift (transfer)

- Peephole on front door
- Well-lit work surfaces

ACCESSIBLE ELEVATOR OR LIFT INSTALLED (select all that apply)

- Minimum of 36" wide level pathway from entrance to elevator/ lift
- Dedicated space for elevator (not installed)
- □ Internal platform lift (stay in wheelchair)

CEILING TRACK (select all that apply)

- Track installed in master bedroom
- Reinforced ceilings
- □ Track installed in bathroom

Reinforced support walls

Elevator permits available

□ External platform lift (stay in wheelchair)

□ Track installed between room

- **SMART TECHNOLOGY** (select all that apply)
 - Automated lighting controls
 - Automated environmental controls
- Automatic door opener

OTHER (select all that apply)

- Fenced yard/ dog run (service dog/ guide dog)
- □ Accessible route to the back yard
